Yuga clashes with Ranma in the Ace Climax Booster: Golden Garga and Violence Vanity!

Many of your favourite cards get new upgrades in these two boosters,

and they're all so good, you won't know which to start with first!



Deity Gargantua Dragon

This is Garga in his best form we've seen so far! Following the first Garga we've seen, you can use this garga in all flags, however, if you use Deity Gargantua Dragon as your buddy, you can use all forms of Garga, even those in other worlds! Not just that, but he holds a fearsome ability as well, DG•EVO, allowing you to attack continuously non-stop!

Sentence of Curse

A new archetype, Curse Dragon, will be introduced in Golden Garga! Used by Light, this deck has a special win condition, thanks to Sentence of Curse! Put cards under your opponent's flag at the start of their turn, and once your opponent has 15 cards under his or her flag, you win! Several cards under this archetype accommodates in adding cards to this as well!





Black Dragon Knight, Geil

The Black Dragon Knight who brings about Judgement, Light's buddy, Geil, assists in achieving the special win condition! When Geil is destroyed, you can put one card under your opponent's flag and return Geil to your hand! Make use of this to add more and more cards under your opponent's flag to victory!

Curse Destruction

Get the chance to add more cards to victory! If there are any Geil cards among the top 2 cards of your deck, you can add 3 cards under your opponent's flag! Additionally, the cast cost is to destroy a curse dragon monster. That means, if you destroy Geil on your field, you can add up to 4 cards to your opponent's flag! this as well!

Vile Demonic Deity Dragon, Vanity Epoch Destroyer

Ranma's buddy, Vanity Destroyer gains new power to the vilest form ever! One unique observation is it's call cost, which to call when a Lost World monster is put into your drop zone! The fight is not over even if you just managed to get rid of a lost world monster!

Venom Swamp

Violence Vanity has several new archetypes as well! And this is just one of the few, Darkvenom Dragon! The main card for this deck is this set spell, Venom Swamp! The special rule of this deck, is that you can keep any number of Venom Swamp in your deck! Yes, that means you can keep more than 4! Venom Swamp has an even more important skill, and that is force your opponent to drop cards from his deck!

The moment Deathraider Orven enters the field, you can take all Venom Swamp from the top three cards of your deck! Deathraider Orven also allows you to destroy any <Darkvenom Dragon> on the field if there's a Venom Swamp spell on your field!

Venom Bind

The most troublesome counter spell has appeared ever (for your opponent that is)! Choose any card of your opponent's and that card's critical is reduced for each Venom Spell spell you have on the field! Use this on your opponent's hardest hitting monsters, and you won't even feel a thing!
































Trial deck 06: Naoki Ishida is released this month, featuring one of my favourite clans—Narukami. Hence, I'd like to introduce a card from this trial deck: Recklessness Dragon.

It can bind a rear-guard on the opponent's front row; meanwhile, its second ability gives it additional 3000 power. With its own ability and other supporting units from Narukami, Recklessness Dragon can effortlessly meet this condition and reach 12000, perfect for attacking Protect and Accel vanguards without boosting, which also makes it an incredible unit to place on the Accel circle.

Cards in your hand essentially become ammo to throw into his AUTO ability that deals damage to your opponent whenever he beats anyone in battle, and you can be sure that's going to happen a lot – 20,000 power, can't use Backups during his battle, and Great Performance work in tandem to ensure you'll always get to use this effect. You can even kick annoying characters to the Memory if you want to!

What Title do you play, and why?


Varied, I like to play a lot of different sets.


